

Manx Electric Railway

If you want to explore the north of the Island, do so in Victorian style by taking a charming electric tramcar. The 17 1/2 mile route from Douglas to Ramsey hugs the Island's east coast, passing through gorse topped hills, glorious Victorian glens and spectacular coastal scenery.

Snaefell Mountain Railway

Alight at Laxey station to change to the Snaefell Mountain Railway – a unique Victorian enterprise. Built in 1895 and famously completed in just seven months, the railway winds from Laxey village to the summit of Snaefell, the Island's only mountain, where breathtaking views await. It is said that from here, you can see seven kingdoms - Mann, England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales, Heaven and Neptune's Realm.



OPERATING DATES: 7 APRIL - 5 NOVEMBER 2017

Isle of Man Steam Railway

Dating back to 1874 the Steam Railway line, which runs 15 1/2 miles from Douglas to Port Erin, is arguably the oldest narrow gauge railway in continuous operation in the British Isles. The railway still uses the original locomotives and rolling stock.

Rocking gently through beautiful countryside watching the train's 'breath' drift by is a timeless experience for rail enthusiasts and visitors of all ages.

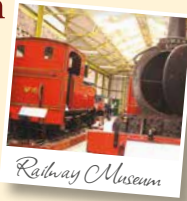


OPERATING DATES: 18 MARCH - 5 NOVEMBER 2017

Isle of Man Railway Museum

A must for all visitors while in Port Erin is the Island's Railway Museum which houses a fine collection of locomotives, rolling stock, railway memorabilia, posters, handbills and interpretive displays. Open from 9.30am to 4.30pm on days the Steam Railway operates. Entry: £2 per adult, £1 per child. Free admission with Go Explore Heritage cards.

Expert guides from our Heritage Railway Volunteers are generally on hand on Sunday mornings from 11am to 1pm to offer tours of the museum. Additionally, guides are available on Thursday evenings between 7.30pm and 9pm from 15 July to 14 September 2017. The museum also boasts a gift shop with an extensive range of railway souvenirs and gifts. Please walk in.



Manx Electric Railway Museum

The Manx Electric Railway was one of the earliest electric railways in the British Isles. There is now a dedicated museum where you can learn more about the history of this pioneering railway. The museum is located inside the main depot at Derby Castle. Open from midday until 4.30pm every Sunday during the MER season. FREE entry.

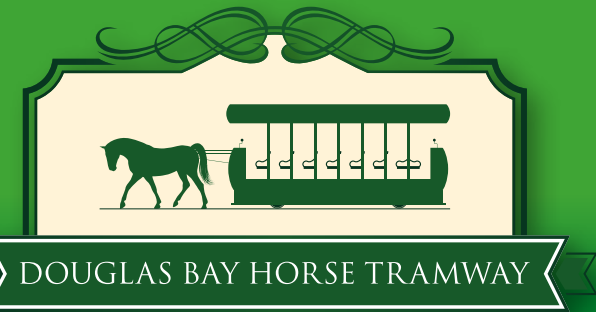
Go cards are available to buy from the Welcome Centre at the Sea Terminal, Douglas, and all main railway stations. The card activation charge is £2 plus:
